Call to Order

Introductions and Welcome

Information on WIA to WIOA

Ms. Lemieux updated the committee on WIA to WIOA changes. One item that did not change is that performance measures which will remain the same until PY'16. Many other rules and regulations are still a work-in-process and will be coming out in Spring 2015 – those changes will be communicated then.

Approve minutes from April 21, 2014 (*Action Item*)

RFP process and scoring (Action Item)

If, when we do go out for bid, there are any remaining in-school youth, whoever gets the youth RFP, it will be explained that they have to continue to serve the current in-school youth.
