Bouncing Back Post-Pandemic is Focus of Virtual Workforce Training Event on February 25

As the COVID-19 pandemic forced the temporary closure of thousands of businesses and the furloughing or permanent layoff of hundreds of thousands of workers, 2020 quickly became one of the most challenging on record. As we look toward broader vaccine distribution and a robust economic recovery in 2021, local and state workforce development partners are presenting its annual, Collaborate to Succeed 6, in a virtual format from 8-11 am on Thursday, Feb. 25, 2021. Presenters will share insights to get you ready for our region's recovery.

The mission of Collaborate to Succeed 6 is to provide business leaders with actionable talent strategies and this year's presentations will provide key takeaways leaders can effectively implement as part of any business strategy. This year, the conference will present best practices by area employers centered on the themes of attracting, hiring, developing and retaining talent. This year, the presenters will dive into the lessons we have learned as the Northeast Wisconsin region faced business disruptions due to the COVID-19 emergency.

- Adopting the Employee Friendly Workplace designation to demonstrate a commitment to company culture to candidates;

Collaborate to Succeed 6 has been developed by a group of regional workforce experts, including representatives from the Fox Valley Workforce Development Board, Fox Valley Technical College, Moraine Park Technical College and the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development.
