

MINUTES Strategic Programs Committee Meeting Thursday, February 3, 2022, 2:30 PM Virtual Meeting

<u>Approval of Agenda</u> (*Action Item*): A motion to approve the agenda was made by Debra Warga. A change of order was requested by Terri Green. Motion to approve the change as well as the approval of the agenda was made by Debra Warga and was approved by committee.

<u>Approval of Minutes from December 2, 2021 Strategic Programs Committee Meeting (Action Item)</u>: A motion was made by Debra Warga to approve the minutes. Committee approved.
