Strategic Programs Committee Meeting

2:30 pm, Thursday, June 13, 2022 Virtual Meeting

Call to Order: Ms. Warga called the meeting to order at 2:31 pm.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u> (Action Item): A motion to approve the agenda was made by Craig Wehner, and seconded by Anna Bierer; motion carried.

Approval of Minutes from May 13, 2022, Strategic Programs Committee Meeting (Action Item): Henry Merrill made a motion to approve the minutes with the correction of two typing errors, seconded by Ryan Long with Craig Wehner abstaining; motion carried.

<u>Approval of Minutes from May 5, 2022, Strategic Programs Committee Meeting (Action Item)</u>: Mark Westphal made a motion to approve the minutes with one edit, seconded by Henry Merrill; motion carried.

<u>Committee Meeting Updates – New Year:</u> The committee agreed to continue virtual meetings with the option for a hybrid meeting as needed. Meetings will remain the first Thursday of the month with a slight change in time, 1:30 - 3:00 pm. Debbie Warga will remain as the Chair and the committee will review the opportunity for new members.

<u>Sub-recipient Updates:</u> Ms. Green updated the committee on basic steps being taking to on-board the Forward Service Corporation. Multiple meetings have taken place to gain insight into hiring, participant notifications and contracts to ensure a smooth transition for a July 1, 2022 effective date.

<u>Job Readiness Program:</u> Ms. Warga started the conversation about the need to provide additional support to resource center clients. This will be an ongoing conversation to develop a plan with job center partners to keep people working and retaining employment. The job center is observing that people are trapped in a cycle of getting a job and losing the job. Initial discussions included ideas related to case management and researching best practices.
