45+ Employers Ready to Hire at Calumet County Career & Job Fair April 10

The Calumet County Career & Job Fair will be held 3:30-5:30 pm, Wednesday, April 10, at Chilton High School, 530 W. Main Street, Chilton. Over forty-five employers from across Calumet County and the region will feature a wide mix of available positions including office, service, manufacturing, healthcare, and other professional positions. Some employers will offer on-site interviews. The job fair is expected to offer a variety of roles: entry level or more skilled, seasonal, temporary, full and part-time. All job seekers regardless of age, education and work experience are welcome.

High school graduating seniors who are unsure of their post-graduation plans are strongly urged to attend and learn more about the great opportunities that are available in the area. On average, nearly 50% of our region's local high school graduating seniors do not have definite plans for after high school. This job fair represents a great opportunity to find meaningful employment as soon as this summer.

In addition to employers, attendees can also speak with individuals from Fox Valley Technical College and the Fox Valley Job Centers about resume development, training opportunities and resources to help you advance your career development.

“Too often, job seekers can feel like they’re sending resumes into an abyss,” said Anthony Snyder, Fox Valley Workforce Development Board CEO. “You might apply and hear nothing. Where else can you meet with more than 45 employers face-to-face in just one day?”
