Some employers will offer on-site interviews. The job fair is expected to offer a variety of roles: entry level or more skilled, seasonal, temporary, full and part-time. **All job seekers regardless of age, education and work experience are welcome. High school graduating seniors who are unsure of their post-graduation plans are strongly urged to attend and learn more about the great opportunities that are available in the area.
