## Oshkosh Area Job Fair May 21 at Menominee Nation Arena; Nearly 100 Employers Ready to Offer You Your Dream Job

The annual Oshkosh Area Job Fair will be held 1-4 pm on Tuesday, May 21, at the Menominee Nation Arena, 1212 S. Main Street, Oshkosh. More than 100 employers from across the region will feature a wide mix of available positions including office, service, manufacturing, healthcare, and other professional positions. In just three hours, job seekers can meet with over 100 of the region's employer representatives.

The job fair is expected to offer a variety of roles: entry level or more skilled, seasonal, temporary, full and part-time. All job seekers regardless of age, education and work experience are welcome. Some employers will offer on-site interviews while others will be accepting resumes and will schedule interviews at a later date.

With nearly 50% of the local high school graduating seniors not going on to college, technical schools or the military, this job fair represents a great opportunity to find meaningful employment as soon as this summer.
