GuideStar Awards Fox Valley Workforce Development Board a Gold Seal in Not-for-Profit Transparency

The Fox Valley Workforce Development Board (FVWDB), based in Neenah, Wis., was recently recognized with a 2018 Gold Seal of Transparency from GuideStar, the world's largest source of information about non-profit organizations in the United States.

FVWDB, a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit, is one of 11 workforce development boards in Wisconsin. The Board leads efforts to create a strong and sustaining workforce in the six counties it represents: Calumet, Green Lake, Fond du Lac, Waupaca, Waushara and Winnebago. The Board leads the region's Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) programs for youth, adults and dislocated/laid off workers and operates six Job Centers in Berlin, Fond du Lac, Menasha, Oshkosh, Waupaca and Wautoma. Other programs of the Fox Valley Workforce Development Board include job skills training for low income workers aged 55 and older, job coaching for inmates soon to be released from Oshkosh and Redgranite Correctional Institutions, career search strategies and resume building for those who are unemployed or underemployed, and working with local employers and technical colleges to develop training programs to upskill workers for critical roles that need to be filled along the I-41 corridor.

In order to be recognized with the 2018 Gold Seal from GuideStar, the FVWDB shared important information with the public on www.guidestar.org, including detailed financial and audit records, information on its Board leadership in-depth reporting about the Board's goals, strategies, capabilities, and progress.

“We're shining a spotlight on the difference we help make in the world,” said Anthony Snyder, the Board's Chief Executive Officer. “Our workforce board helps people get the skills they need to find a career with a family-sustaining wage. This leads to more secure housing, better nutrition and access to decent transportation. We're giving people a chance to succeed financially in ways they never thought possible.”
