## **May 7, 2025 Oshkosh Area Employment Fair Offered for Job Seekers at Sunnyview Expo Center in Oshkosh**

The Fox Valley Workforce Development Board (FVWDB) will once again host the annual Oshkosh Area Employment Fair, 10 am – 1 pm, Wednesday, May 7, 2025, at Sunnyview Expo Center, 500 E County Y, Oshkosh. Job seekers are urged to prepare now with a refreshed resume and a plan for their next role.

Companies attending the fair will be able to connect with many job seekers during the three-hour community fair. Each year, this event brings in hundreds of job seekers across all skill levels. In addition to welcoming job seekers from the community, this year the fair has expanded to also include the first-ever partnership with the Student Talent Track Powered by the Oshkosh Chamber of Commerce; this will allow companies to reach an audience of area high school students who will be seeking full-time permanent roles after graduation or youth apprenticeship opportunities.

More than 50 employers across various industries, including office, service, manufacturing, healthcare, and other professional positions, will be looking for their next new hires.

During the fair, job seekers of all skill levels can connect directly with hiring managers and learn about available positions. Some companies will even conduct on-site interviews, making this event a fantastic chance to make an immediate impact.

“Roles range from entry level to more skilled, seasonal, temporary, full and part-time. All job seekers regardless of age, education and work experience are welcome,” said Anthony Snyder, CEO of FVWDB. “Some employers will offer on-site interviews while others will be accepting resumes and will schedule interviews at a later date. It’s not often you get to hand your resume right to a human being, versus submitting it online. These will be real companies with real positions available and it’s a unique opportunity for job seekers to connect directly with companies from across our region, so we urge job seekers to take full advantage.”

Job seekers are encouraged to bring resumes to share and to dress for the career they want.
