Appointment details:

Appointments are 50 minutes in length. A maximum of two appointments per week,
 per person, can be scheduled.

- Appointments will only take place Mondays 8:30 am-12:30 pm, Tuesdays Noon-4 pm, Wednesdays 8:30 am-12:30 pm, and Thursdays Noon-4 pm.
- Visitors must have basic computer skills to independently navigate the computer's
 operation. Staff are available for limited assistance to adhere to 6-feet of social
 distancing. One additional person can be brought to the appointment to input data
 into the computer if necessary.
- Properly worn face masks by all staff and visitors are required.
- Job center staff continue to provide job searching and career exploration services
 via phone, email and other virtual platforms.
