Oshkosh Area Food Trucks Wanted for September 12 Rally and Job Fair at Sunnyview Exposition Center

The annual Oshkosh Area Job Fair will be held 3-6 pm on Tuesday, September 12, 2023, at Sunnyview Exposition Center, 500 E County Rd Y, Oshkosh. While this regional job fair has been a staple in the community for several years, this year's event has a new and exciting twist thanks to a grant from The New North, our regional economic development partner, that will allow us to provide a meal to every job seeker between the hours of 4-7 pm.

According to Anthony Snyder, Fox Valley Workforce Development Board CEO, "Food truck rallies are all the rage right now and people visiting the job fair recruiters from 3-6 pm will be able to enjoy food offered by area food truck vendors from 4-7 pm. This is an exciting new feature to our fair and we think everyone attending will enjoy getting a taste of all the cool things the Oshkosh area has to offer – whether it be a new job or some unique food they haven't yet tried."

Thanks to a diversity focused entrepreneurship grant funded by The New North, job seekers who visit at least five (5) participating company booths will be eligible to receive \$15

worth of food tokens to be used at the food trucks participating at the fair. Employer representatives manning the recruitment booths will be fed well from these food trucks.

"We always get well over 100 employers at this annual job fair and usually do great with job seekers," said Snyder. "What we need now are a wide variety of food trucks to join us."
